DanChurchAid is launching a Local Open Tender and invites interested candidates to participate in the Procurement Procedure for:

- Web development support for the Fabo learning platform, built on Moodle LMS.
 - 2–3 days of support per month over a four-year contract period, with the possibility of extending for an additional 12 months.
1. The services are for the Fabo Learning Community, a member-driven global learning community of 30 civil society organisations facilitated by DanChurchAid's Learning Lab. The intervention supported by the Fabo learning community.
 2. Services will be delivered remotely.
 3. The offered prices shall be quoted in DKK or EUR only.
 4. **Eligibility and qualification requirements.** Tenderers are not eligible to participate in the Tender Procedure if they are in one of the situations listed in article 33 of the General Terms and Conditions for Service Contracts – Ver3 2020.

Tenderers shall in the Tender Submission Form attest that they meet the above eligibility criteria. If required by the Contracting Authority, the Tenderer whose tender is accepted shall further provide evidence satisfactory to the Contracting Authority of its eligibility through certificates issued by competent authorities in its country of establishment or operation, or, if such certificates are not available, through a sworn statement.

Exclusion from award of contracts. Contracts may not be awarded to Tenderers who, during the Procurement Procedure:

- (a) are subject to conflict of interest; and/or
- (b) are guilty of misrepresentation in supplying the information required as a condition of participation and eligibility in the Tender Procedure or fail to supply this information.

Award Criteria. Candidates will be evaluated based on technical criteria as outlined in the Tender Dossier, with a maximum technical score of 100 points. The Contracting Authority reserves the right to discard offers below a technical score of 80 points. Award will be made to the most technically qualified candidate meeting the requirements at the best value for money.

5. All offers, in English language only, must be submitted not later than April 30, 2026, as per the instructions in the Tender Dossier. Late bids will be rejected.
6. An opening report will be made and shared with eligible candidates
